Our vision is to create a community-based, family-focused, and comprehensive system that responds to needs through cooperative planning efforts. Preston Prevention Partnership (PPP/P³)

Family Support Center (FSC)

Formerly known as Starting Points, the Family Support Center (FSC) is a family education and support program for children and families aged from birth to eighteen and funded through DHHR/BCR. The program promotes literacy, child development, health and nutrition, child abuse and neglect prevention, parenting skills and family support services. Activities include weekly playgroups in two different locations in the county, a baby swap, baby pantry, community events, the Dolly Parton Books project, United Way Shaken Baby Syndrome program and Books for Babies Project.

The FSC also has a Food Pantry, Baby Pantry and Hygiene Kits for anyone that just needs a little help. There are no income checks for our support services – please note some services may have monthly or yearly limits per family or individual. Stop by **105 West High Street Kingwood M-F 8:00am-4:00pm** and follow the FSC on Facebook to learn more about events, services, and changes in hours.

Parent Resource Navigator (PRN)

The PRN program is a court appointed service to help families reunite. The responsibilities of the Parent Navigator (PN) include providing parenting coaching, teaching, and offering information, referrals, and links to available community resources. Additionally, the PN actively works to advance the family's home management skills by promoting the development of organizational and budget management skills, ultimately working towards family self-sufficiency.

Healthy Grandfamilies

Regardless of your family's current situation, we offer support services to help Grandparents raising their grand and great-grandchildren. We provide free support and training for health and nutrition; legal issues; general parenting; substance use prevention; navigating the school system and a support group of friendly faces to talk to. We can also help with overdue housing and utility concerns. Preston/Taylor Parents as Teachers (PAT)

The Parents as Teachers Program is a home-visitation program for all families with kids prenatal to kindergarten entry. We focus on school readiness and helping children meet developmental milestones, we help parents connect to resources in the area that can assist you with food, utilities etc., we offer free monthly events for community members to connect with each other that are family focused, educational and fun! There are no income guidelines! One visit is required per month, about 60 minutes. Visits typically take place in your home! Our parent educator can also meet you virtually or at a park, library etc.

Circle of Parents

Circle of Parents is a group where parents and caregivers share ideas, celebrate successes, and address the challenges surrounding parenting. PAT/CoP coordinates self-care activities each month. CoP is open to all parents in the county. If interested in joining, contact the PAT program.

Partners in Prevention (PIP)

Preston PIP promotes strong and safe families through evidence-based programs, community outreach, personal development, and education. Our Baby Shower provides participants with Shaken Baby, Period of Purple Crying, and Car Seat Safety training. Stewards of Light educates adults on child abuse prevention and how to react responsibly to children that disclose abuse. We focus on community-wide prevention through Pinwheels, ACEs, and SAP activities. Circle of Parents, Grandfamilies, and Fatherhood events provide activities and social connection for parents.
